



EINIG-ZENZEN WINES

DR ZENZEN - SILVANER

BACKGROUND:

Rheinhessen is the largest Silvaner cultivation area in the world. At the beginning of the 1960s, every second vine in Rheinhessen was still a Silvaner. This is a thing of the past, but the Silvaner with its 2,320 hectares of vineyards - almost 9% of the total area - remains a treasure trove of almost 10 million vines.

TASTING NOTES:

Typical Silvaner with elements of pear, elderflower, herbs and earthy tones.

FOOD SUGGESTIONS:

Fits perfectly to veal, pork, vegetarian, poultry, lean fish.

SERVING:

Serve chilled at 7-9 °C
